The workshop centres around a day of practical photography (bring your camera) covering three different themes. Each of these is presented by highly qualified photographers, all providing an opportunity for you to expand your own photographic skills. The lead presenter is Laurie Campbell who will run a session on wildlife and macro photography as well as giving the closing lecture of the day.

The themes for the 2012 workshop are:-

**Wild Life and Macro Photography** - Laurie Campbell

**Sports Photography** - George Neilson ARPS

**Portraiture** - Colin Wilkinson

Where possible all workshops (with perhaps the exception of the Sports photography) will be outdoors (weather permitting) allowing full use of natural light and the backdrop of the village buildings. All sessions are organised to maximise hands on experience for the individual. Attendees will participate in all three workshops.

**Laurie Campbell** is one of Scotland's leading natural history and landscape photographers. His award winning photographs regularly feature in magazines, books, exhibitions, displays and company reports and are distributed in a wide range of products.

**George Neilson ARPS** is currently President of Edinburgh Photographic Society and is well known as a club lecturer and judge. One of George's interests is sports photography and he has photographed many different types of sport so will be able to offer lots of advice on this subject.

**Colin Wilkinson** is a regular club presenter and leader of workshops, mainly on portraiture. Colin is also heavily involved with theatre photography.
